

# Chief Purification water filter cleaning instructions:



### Step 1:

Attach drain hoses to both the backwash and forwardwash hose bibs.




#### Step 5:

Close the hose bib next to the Blue valve to stop the water flow.


Open the Blue valve (turn it parallel to the pipe) - Then close the Black valve (turn it perpindicular to the pipe)

Turning the valves in this position will start the forwardwash process.



## Step 2:

Rotate the Orange cutoff valve to the off position. (off position is perpindicular to the pipe)




#### Step 6:

Open the hose bib next to the Orange valve to start the water flow. This begins the frowardwash process.


Allow the water to run until the water turns clear.

(similar to the backwash process, crimp the hose for a few seconds at a time to help in the cleaning process.)



# Step 3:

Rotate the Blue valve to the off position (perpindicular to the pipe) - Then rotate the Black valve to the on position. (parallel with the pipe)




# Step 7:

Close the hose bib next to the Orange valve to stop the water flow.

Repeat steps 1-7 a few times backwashing and forwardwashing the filter to clean the filter completely.

Once the filter is clean, open the Blue valve, close the Black valve - Then open the Orange valve allowing water back to the home.




Step 4:

Open the hose bib next to the Blue valve to start the backflush process. You are now allowing water to run through the filter in reverse beginning the cleaning process.

Let the water run until the water begins to turn clear.

(tip: crimp the hose for a few seconds at a time to momentarily build pressure in the filter to help in the cleaning process)



#### Step 8:

Remove the hoses from the forwardwash and backwash hose bibs.
